About the Project

This is your chance to be a part of the Schoolyard Planting Project in Huron County - bring new beauty and function to your school and learn about native plant species from your local conservation authority! This project will involve the development of stimulating school landscape designs that feature native species.

Three Grade 6 classes in Huron County will be chosen to take part in this exciting initiative and will be given the opportunity to work with a landscape architect to prepare designs for a new outdoor classroom at their school! The designs will involve the planting of more than 105 trees and shrubs, along with other local species. Design will take place this school year and planting will take place next September when the classes enter Grade 7. The selected classes will also receive a presentation courtesy of the local conservation authority (MVCA or ABCA) about sustainability, the importance of native species in our environment, and how to plant and maintain the trees.

The Schoolyard Planting Project is an early win project for the Huron County Sustainability Plan.
